FENNEC FOX

- . The **fennec fox** lives in North Africa and the Sahara Desert.
- 2. It's nocturnal, hunting at night to avoid the daytime heat.
- 3. They live in underground dens in groups of up to 10 foxes.
- 4. They eat plants, eggs, small rodents, reptiles and insects.
- 5. Though small, **fennec foxes** are pretty springy and can leap over a metre (4 feet) to catch prey.



They get all the water they need from the food they eat or from licking condensation inside their dens.

- . There are six different species of **flamingo** and they live all over the world.
- 2. The name flamingo means 'flame-coloured' in Spanish and Portuguese. They get their colour from the plankton and crustaceans they eat.
- 3. They eat by stirring up mud with their feet, scooping it in their beaks and straining food from the mud.
- 4. Nobody really knows why flamingos stand on one leg. Scientists are still trying to work it out.
- **5. Flamingos** live in colonies of thousands of birds. Flocking together is a good way to scare off predators.



Flamingos kept in captivity turn white if they don't have enough crustaceans in their diet.
