- 1. Archeologists have found evidence that humans were eating apples as long ago as 6500 BC!
- 2. More than 7500 different types of apples trees around the world. They include Fuji, Gala, Red Delicious, Golden Delicious, Pink Lady and Granny Smith!
- 3. Apple trees take a long time to mature! It takes four to ten years before a young apple tree can produce fruit...
- 4. Apple trees are pollinated by insects including honey bees!
- 5. The trees typically blossom in spring with fruit maturing in autumn. The blossoms are usually white, yellow or pink.
- 6. An apple tree can easily live for 100 years or more if it is not damagaed or affected by disease.
 - 7. Apple trees can be grown from seeds or from a cutting. Cuttings can also be attached (grafted) onto another tree!
 - 8. Apple trees are decidious, meaning they lose their leaves in Autumn and grow back in Spring
 - China grows the most apples in the world, followed by the United States, Turkey, Poland and Italy.
