A word for why a character does something is 'motivation'. If the hero doesn't have motivation, they won't do anything and the story won't happen!

A story's theme is its deeper message. It relates to the central conflict and what was learned in the end. WHAT do you think was the

theme of the story you read?

## SETTINGS



WHERE is the story set?

Is it in a fictional country or a real-life place? Does it have a name? Look for clues like buildings, clothes and plants and animals

WHEN does it take place?

It could be set in the modern day, in the past, or in the ruture! Is it set in one day or over a long time?

> Stories called rables have strong themes — they often tell you what the 'moral' is at the end! Muths are usually about battles between opposing forces of the universe and fairy tales can be about the value friendship, honesty or hard work!

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
